#### **Financials**

Cori let the board know that we have received a bid from Kenyon enterprises for some sprinklers where we do not currently have any. She told the board we do have money in the budget to make those upgrades.

Sandy Volle moved to approve the financial report as presented. Charles Dunten seconded, motion carried.

### **PROGRAM REPORTS**

Donna Schnitker submitted the program reports for **Early Childhood and Special Education** to the Board which can be found in the board packet.

ECC Assistant Director Brenda Engebretsen highlighted the programs report for Early Childhood and Special Education.

Brenda said the Head Start summer school concluded last Thursday and said it was very successful. Brenda said they were funded for 30 students and had 28 students attend. She said the students and teachers were all so happy to be back in school with each other and said it was also great to have extra time back in the class before the students start kindergarten this coming school year.

Brenda said if the Early Learning Council approves the new Guidance on the 13<sup>th</sup>, Head Start will be able to open with full enrollment. She said the Early Learning Division awarded us enough money to open to additional extended day classes. This will not serve more students but rather no longer have double sessions.

EI/ECSE numbers remain stable and will be sending 8 students off to kindergarten.

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Brenda told the board they will no longer have Great Start. She said they have received funding for a new program called Preschool Promise. She said this will be treated much like Head Start. It will be serving fewer children, but for more days and hours. Brenda said this program is exciting because it will have stable funding. Brenda said herself and Donna wrote two grants to receive these funds.

The frontier Hub is still working on coordinated enrollment.

### **Superintendent Report**

**In-services – Harney ESD In-service- August 19<sup>th</sup>, Rural In-service – August 20<sup>th</sup>** Superintendent Criss discussed what the agenda looks like for both Teacher/Staff in-services. Discussion followed.

### **Ready Schools Safe Learning Reopening Plan**

Superintendent Criss discussed the Ready Schools Safe Learning Reopening Plan as of August 12<sup>th</sup>. She said the plans are continuously changing due to the restriction guidelines the state puts out, sometimes changing several times in one day. Superintendent Criss stated as of today the plan for the rural schools is to be back in school full time and she discussed what that would look like.
