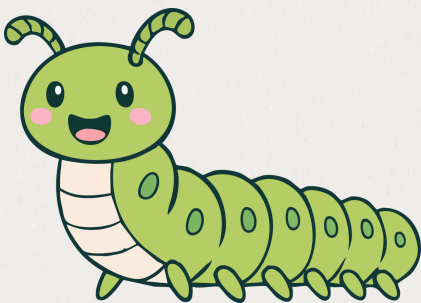

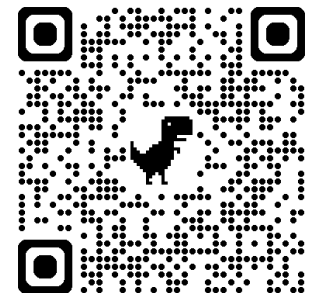
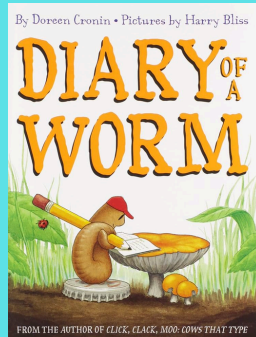
Spring has Arrived at ECC!

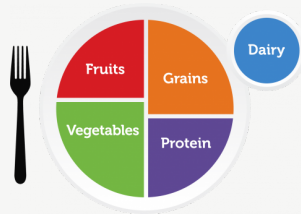
Banana Sushi
