Board Chair, Doug Stott, opened the Public Hearing for the 2026-2027 Budget at 1:33 PM.

ACTION ITEMS

Consent Agenda

- Consent Agenda included the following:

After review of the Consent Agenda, Sandy Volle made a motion to approve as presented. Charles Dunten seconded. No discussion. Motion carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

- Let the minutes reflect that Tom Doman made a motion to approve Cheyenne Fowler as a signer and to remove Shannon Criss, making adjustments to the First Community Credit Acct. ending in 0002. Sandy Volle seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
- Eric Andersson asked the board to approve the surplus of the 2021 Dodge Journey. Charles Dunten made a motion to surplus the vehicle and Sandy Volle seconded the motion. This was unanimously approved.
- Cheyenne Fowler recognized Janet Caldwell, Cori Wright and Keely Randall for their years of service to the ESD.

OLD BUSINESS

PRESENTATIONS AND REPORTS

Financials

Business Manager, Cori Wright, went over the Financial Report, full report is in the packet. Disbursements were discussed and two resolutions were handed out for the 2025-2026 fiscal year. Discussion was held.

First Resolution - To Transfer Monies Within a Fund- Per ORS 294.463 which allows the transfer of appropriations within a fund during the fiscal year. This Resolution increases the Function 1000 appropriation from \$960,101 to \$1,510,101 and decreases the Function 2000 appropriation from \$4,729,992 to \$4,179,992 in Special Revenue Funds (200).

Second Resolution - To Recognize and Expend Unexpected Grant Funds for Niemeyer Grant- Per ORS 294.326 which specifies that expenditures of grants shall be lawful only after enactment by the governing body of appropriation ordinance or resolution authorizing the expenditure. This Resolution recognizes the John & Ginger Niemeyer Foundation Grant in the amount of \$30,000 and authorizes the expenditures in 233.3300.0390 and 233.3300.0410.

Tom Doman moved to approve the financials as presented and to adopt the Resolution for FY 25-26 to Transfer Monies Within and Fund as presented and the Resolution for FY 25-26 to Recognize and Expend Unexpected Grant Funds (correcting the date to FY 25-26) as amended. Sandy Volle seconded the motion; the motion passed unanimously.

Superintendent Report

Cheyenne Fowler shared the following:

- Nearing the end of the ESD's re-organization and concluding contracts with Oster's. Keely and Cori have trained personnel, and the ESD is hiring for the front desk position. All districts have signed the menu of services in March.
- Cheyenne read Shannon's good-bye letter.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

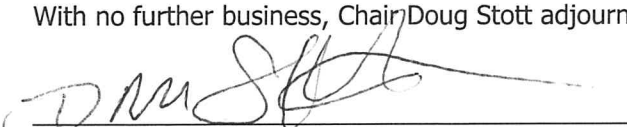
- Doug asked that we get a professional sign for the ESD and Cori confirmed that there is money in the budget to address this.
